

In Lisbon metropolitan area, planned urban agriculture spaces have seen a huge development in the past 10 years. Almost all of the spaces for this activity are public held and public leaded by City Halls. However, there's one experiment, unique in Portugal: a community led urban agricultural park in the Alta de Lisboa (Lisbon Uptown) area. Created and managed by the local community, it's a lesson on bottom-up approaches to green infrastructure implementation. In this MW we'll understand all the story, challenges and potential of this agricultural park, in an inspiring voyage to a civic ecology and social cohesion movement in the city.
